Healthcare

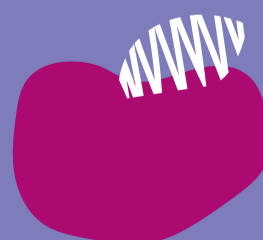


- Health Clinic for people who do not have Medicare access.
